| The new change style of house is not in keeping with the architectural style of local houses in the area. The house does not blend into the countryside, and it is too modern to be built across road from Flatfield. | Following a site inspection and an assessment of planning policy and all other material considerations it is considered that the proposal complies with the relevant planning policy context. A variety of house types are seen in the area. The design of the dwellings are thought to be appropriate for this rural location and are of a similar design to other dwellings within the area. The dwellings will be appropriately integrated into the surroundings by the existing and proposed vegetation. Each application is assessed on its own merits and in consideration of the surrounding area as whole.  Change of house type applications are not uncommon in these circumstances. The change to the design has been assessed as above and are found to be acceptable under policy. There is a mix of house types seen in the area.
